And the five little pumpkins rolled out of sight*

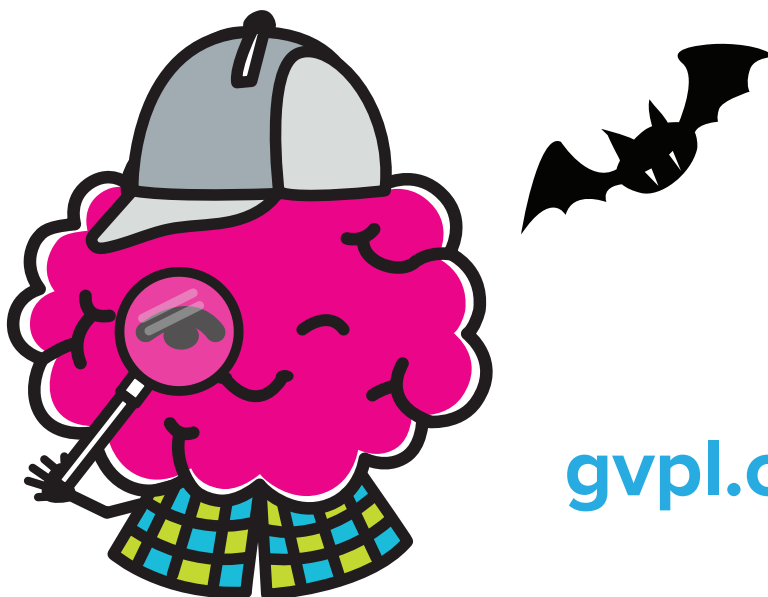
